# **Current Project**

- Braille and raised print plates
- Current project to cover roughly 10% of AC Transit's 5100 (pre-pandemic) bus stops, depending on options chosen
- \$35,000 is budgeted for the current project



# Seeking input

- Content of braille/raised print plates
- Stop selection for braille/raised print plates
- Future projects



# Possible content of plates

• "Bus"

– (to mark bus stop poles as separate from other signposts)

- Bus line numbers / letters?
- Stop ID numbers?

Trade-off between complexity and number of stops covered

# Stop selection

- Stop selection options for initial project
  - Highest boardings
  - Transit centers with multiple stops
    (Approximately 25 BART stations and other centers)
  - Locations with facilities geared to the visually impaired



### Next steps

Future projects might include:

- Extending plates to more (possibly all) stops
   Very rough estimate of \$315,000
- Suggestions for other projects to pursue

MTC working on new regional standards to include wayfinding
