

Item #3C – Update on Transportation Projects

Oakland/AC Transit ILC Meeting – 9/21/22

TIRCP Grant

- **Location:** Clay St (Embarcadero to 2nd) and 2nd Street (Jefferson & Washington)
- **Scope:**
 - New bus shelters, benches, pedestrian-scale lighting, landscaping, real-time transit arrival information, a staging and transition location for transit riders and bus operators, and concrete bus pads will be installed to support daily AC Transit operations connecting to Broadway bus only lanes.
 - Space for shared micromobility will be designated in the vicinity of the new Transportation Hub to support alternative and sustainable modes of travel.
 - Wayfinding signage will be installed to enhance the pedestrian and bicycle experience by directing people to and from BART, Amtrak, the Ferry, and the new Transportation Hub.
 - Existing sidewalks on the south side of 2nd Street between Jefferson Street and Clay Street will be reconstructed and expanded to accommodate pedestrians traveling to and from the new Transportation Hub.
 - All-way stop signs at 6 surrounding intersections
- **Status:** 10% design, coordination between AC Transit and Oakland ongoing, funding through construction secured

Location: San Pablo Avenue, Telegraph Avenue, West Grand/Grand Avenue

Scope:

- Bus stop improvements along Telegraph and West Grand/Grand Avenue
- Improve traffic signals
- Repair some sidewalks

Status: Construction (Fall 2022 – Late 2023)
