## A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CLEAN AIR DAY

**WHEREAS,** air pollution contributes to higher rates of cancer and heart and lung diseases, which adversely affect health; and

**WHEREAS,** numerous communities throughout the AC Transit service area have some of the worst air quality in the United States; and

**WHEREAS,** it is vital that we protect the health and well-being of our residents, visitors, and workforce; and

WHEREAS, emissions from vehicles, industry, and even household sources significantly affects the natural environment, air quality and well-being of San Francisco East Bay residents; and

**WHEREAS,** individual actions such as riding public transportation, walking or biking to work and school can directly improve air quality in our region; and

WHEREAS, transportation is the number one source of emissions in the State of California; and

**WHEREAS,** if the average driver took public transit instead of driving just two days a week, it would save 1,600 pounds of greenhouse gas emissions each year; and

**WHEREAS,** AC Transit employees, vendors and board directors have tremendous power to help lower emissions; and

WHEREAS, pledges by individuals have shown to result in action; and

**WHEREAS,** education about air quality can raise community awareness, encourage our community to develop better habits, and improve our community health; and

**WHEREAS,** Californians will be joining together across the state to clear the air on October 5, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, AC Transit is committed to the health of the residents, workforce, and visitors in the communities that we serve, and community at large.

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Board of Directors of the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District does resolve as follows:

**Section 1.** that the District support Clean Air Day on October 5, 2022.
