A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE CORRECTED APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIII B OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 20-037

WHEREAS, Article XIII B to the Constitution of the State of California places appropriations limitations on the fiscal powers of the State and each local government; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 7910 provides that each year the governing body of each jurisdiction shall establish its Appropriations Limit pursuant to Article XIII B at a regularly scheduled meeting or special meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors on October 14, 2020, adopted Resolution 20-052 providing notice to the public, as required by Government Code Section 7910, that the Board of Directors would establish the corrected Appropriations Limit for Fiscal Year 2020-21 at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 12, 2020; and

WHEREAS, no public comment was received regarding the District's appropriation limit for Fiscal Year 2020-21.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby establishes the corrected Appropriations Limit for Fiscal Year 2020-21 for the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District at \$550,464,750 as documented in Exhibits A and B attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. Repeals Resolution No. 20-037 in its entirety.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by four affirmative votes of the Board of Directors.
