Agency	Recent/Planned Fare Increases?	Clipper Discount?*
BART	Increased fares by 6.2% on January 1, 2026, raising the average fare by about \$0.30.	None
Caltrain	Increase of “zone upgrade fare” by \$0.25 on January 1, 2027	Eliminated a \$0.55 Clipper discount for standard and monthly fares on January 1, 2026
SamTrans	None	\$0.20 Clipper discount (\$2.05 vs \$2.25)
SF Muni	General increase of \$0.10 planned on January 1, 2028	\$0.15 Clipper discount (\$2.85 vs \$3.00) The discount was reduced from \$0.50 to \$0.25 on January 1, 2025, and again from \$0.25 to \$0.15 on July 1, 2025. The discount will be removed on January 1, 2027.
VTA	None, studying fares currently	No discount, local transfer only available with Clipper
SF Bay Ferry	Fares increased on all routes by 1%-6% on July 1, 2026.	None
Golden Gate Transit	Regional fares increased by up to \$0.25 on July 1, 2026, local fare was unchanged.	\$0.10 or \$0.20 Clipper discount (depending on fare type)
County Connection	None	\$0.50 Clipper discount (\$2.00 vs \$2.50)
Wheels (LAVTA)	Fare increase of \$0.50 on April 1, 2026.	\$0.25 Clipper discount (\$2.25 vs \$2.50)
Tri-Delta Transit	None	No discount, local transfer only available with passes or Clipper
WestCAT	None	None
Marin Transit	None	10% Clipper Discount within Marin County
