Introduction

Encourage and support shuttle operations that serve as access to transit

Shuttle Management

- BART manages curbs/bus zones at most stations, sometimes with the City
- BART does not manage curbs at 12th St, 19th St, or Downtown Berkeley
- Continue to learn about shuttles using stations

Types of Shuttles

- Open to the public vs. not open to the public
- First/last mile vs. longer distance
- Event shuttles
- Business district, commute management organizations, hospital, university, school buses, private employers

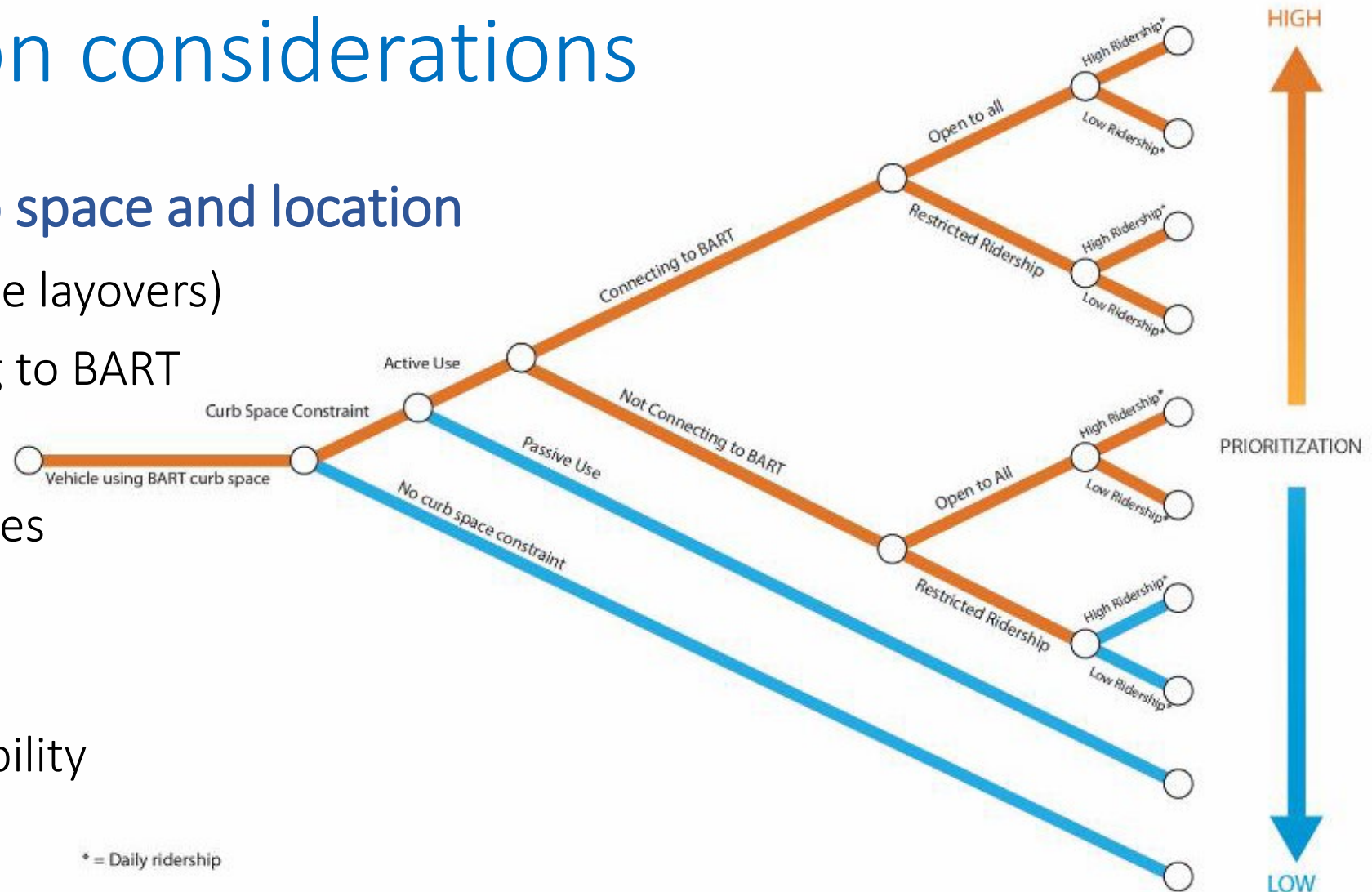
Curb allocation considerations

Prioritization for curb space and location

- Active use (de-prioritize layovers)
- Passengers connecting to BART
- Open to the public
- Higher ridership services

Other considerations

- Special needs, accessibility
- Passenger experience
- Operations: routing, schedules, vehicle size

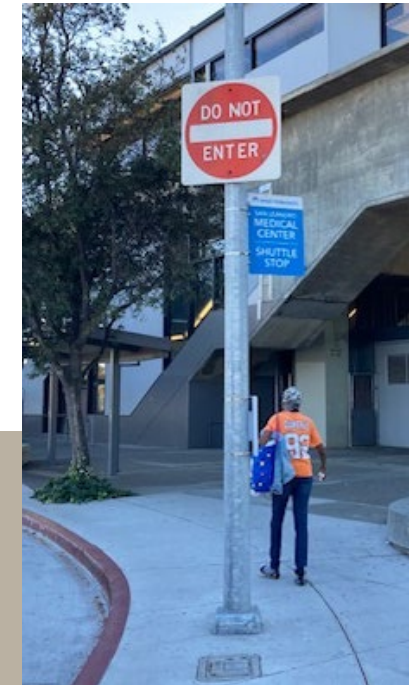


Signage and maps

Allow/include only for services open to the public

Services open to the public: Must meet signage specifications

Services not open to the public: Bus bay numbers and generic “shuttle” signs for other services



North of Oakland

- Richmond: Flixbus, Kaiser
- El Cerrito Del Norte: FlixBus, Richmond Moves, employer shuttle,
- El Cerrito Plaza: None
- North Berkeley: Kaiser, employer shuttles
- Downtown Berkeley: BART does not manage curbs
- Ashby: West Berkeley Shuttle, employer shuttles

Oakland

- MacArthur: Emery Go Round, hospital shuttles (Alta Bates, Kaiser, Childrens Hospital), Mills College, CalTrans Bike Shuttle
- Rockridge: Lawrence Berkeley Labs, Mills College, school bus, employer shuttles
- 19th St: BART does not manage curbs
- 12th St: BART does not manage curbs
- Lake Merritt: Alameda County, Highland Hospital, employer Shuttles
- West Oakland: The Emery, FlixBus, Greyhound
- Fruitvale: Employer shuttle
- Coliseum: Employer shuttle, hotel shuttle (on-demand)

South of Oakland

- San Leandro: San Leandro Flex and Links, Kaiser
- Bay Fair: San Leandro Flex, Alameda County Sustainability
- Castro Valley: CSUEB, employer shuttle
- Hayward: CSUEB, Greyhound, employer shuttle
- S. Hayward: N/A
- Union City: Employer shuttles
- Fremont: Marguerite, employer shuttles
- Warm Springs: Employer shuttles
- Milpitas, Berryessa: Managed by VTA
