## ALAMEDA-CONTRA COSTA TRANSIT DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO. 25-016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM GENERAL MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO FILE AND EXECUTE APPLICATIONS AND FUNDING AGREEMENTS WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ALLOCATION OF THE CALIFORNIA STATE OF GOOD REPAIR PROGRAM; AND TO PROVIDE CERTIFICATIONS AND ASSURANCES AND ASSIGN THE INTERIM GENERAL MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, AS THE AUTHORIZED AGENT FOR THE CALIFORNIA STATE OF GOOD REPAIR PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District (District) is an eligible project sponsor and may receive State Transit Assistance funding from the State of Good Repair (SGR) Program for transit projects; and

**WHEREAS,** the statutes related to state-funded transit projects require a local or regional implementing agency to abide by various regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (2017) named the Department of Transportation (Department) as the administrative agency for the SGR; and

**WHEREAS,** the Department has developed guidelines for the purpose of administering and distributing SGR funds to eligible project sponsors (local agencies); and

**WHEREAS**, the District wishes to delegate authorization to execute these documents and any amendments thereto to the Interim General Manager, Kathleen Kelly.

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Board of Directors of the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District does resolve as follows:

- <u>Section 1.</u> The District as the fund recipient agrees to comply with all conditions and requirements set forth in the Certification and Assurances and the Authorized Agent documents and applicable statutes, regulations and guidelines for all SGR funded transit projects.
- <u>Section 2.</u> Interim General Manager, Kathleen Kelly, or her designee, is authorized to execute all required documents of the SGR program and any Amendments thereto with the California Department of Transportation.
- **Section 3.** Authorizes the following project nominations for the FY 2025-2026 SGR funds:
  - 1. Maintain state of good repair, upgrade, rehabilitate or make improvements to the District's existing transportation infrastructure or facilities.

<u>Section 4.</u> This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by four affirmative votes of the Board of Directors.
