<b>Public Comment:</b>						
<p><b>Katy Scott-Smith</b>, PTA-EBDSA, voiced support for municipally funded transit trips. Scott-Smith noted how a pilot program at the City of Berkeley shows how the District would benefit from municipally funded transit and advocated for the Board to do everything to implement, lobby for, and promote municipally funded transit.</p> <p><b>Dori Goldberg</b>, PTA-EBDSA, noted that AC Transit should move forward to obtain the municipal transit funds from the City of Berkeley, as riders are responding very well to fare-free transit. Goldberg noted that the use of alternative funding mechanisms for transit takes the burden off individual transit riders.</p> <p><b>Chris Nosso</b>, Aide to Berkeley Councilmember Kate Harrison, expressed support for the approval for municipal funded transit. Nosso noted ways that the City of Berkeley provides subsidies around town and how such subsidies benefits riders, the community, and the environment.</p>
