

- This Project will implement recommendations in AC Transit's 2016 Major Corridors Study.
- The Major Corridors Study recommends improvements to help buses run faster and more reliably on 11 major corridors carrying more than half the people who ride AC Transit buses.

Together, these improvements will:






Enhance Transit Reliability





Improvements will be made along four miles of Telegraph Avenue from 20th Street in Oakland to Downtown Berkeley.






