BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

Per Board Policy 100 - Board policies contained in Section 400 shall be reviewed as-needed or at a minimum of every five years, except for Procurement and Materials policies, which are to be reviewed every two years. The existing language is consistent with current District practices and continues to comply with the U.S. Department of Transportation and Federal Transit Administration Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program requirements.
