




Transit Access without Richmond Moves



Transit Access with Richmond Moves





The April zone expansion has contributed to drive rapid growth in Richmond Moves






Most popular ride PU/DOs overlaid with rail network



I work in San Francisco and being able to get affordable ride to the Richmond ferry terminal is great thru Richmond Moves. In other services, Via has seen that the introduction of microtransit has corresponded with an increase to fixed route ridership



After microtransit was introduced in Salt Lake City, ridership on overlapping *fixed route lines increased by over 24%*; Via could help conduct a similar analysis leveraging AC Transit ridership data

Via is working to update the Richmond Moves app to better highlight AC transit options
