WHEREAS, the Board of Directors adopted Resolution 23-004 on January 25, 2023, approving the mid-year amendment to the FY 2022-23 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has received and reviewed the General Manager's recommended addition of two time-limited Principal Planner positions to the Mid-Year Budget for the FY 2022-23 General Fund Operating Budget;

WHEREAS, the time-limited positions will be funded by grants allocated by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) increasing revenues by approximately \$141,000,

WHEREAS, the approximately \$141,000 expense for these positions will be entirely reimbursable and result in a net zero budget impact to the District, and

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District does resolve as follows:

Section 1. Approves the Amended Recommended General Fund Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-23 in the amount of \$544.9 million with the staff increases incorporated below as identified and described in Staff Report 22-158e.
