INTENT TO FINANCE A PUBLIC CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Government Code Section 6586.5, that the AC Transit Board of Directors will hold a Public Hearing on **Wednesday, July 10, 2019, at 5:00 p.m.** at the AC Transit General Offices, Second Floor Board Room, 1600 Franklin Street, Oakland, California, to consider public comment on whether the financing of a portion of the construction costs associated with the Bus Rapid Transit Project, a public capital improvement in the Cities of San Leandro and Oakland, will provide a significant public benefit, including employment benefits and more efficient delivery of services.

Public Comment may be provided orally or in writing in lieu of attending the public hearing if received no later than the close of the hearing on Wednesday, July 10, 2019.
