WHEREAS, the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District ("AC Transit") is submitting applications for funding to the Bay Area Air Quality Management District ("Air District") through the Vehicle Trip Reduction Grant program; and

WHEREAS, the application is to support the operations of the on-demand shuttle service, AC Transit Flex Service, with a request for up to \$1,500,000 in funds; and

WHEREAS, the Air District is the regional air pollution control agency for the nine county San Francisco Bay Area; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District ("District") does resolve as follows:

- **Section 1.** The project is approved for submission to the Air District.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The General Manager, Michael A. Hursh, is authorized to submit the application and carry out the project.
- **Section 3.** AC Transit will secure matching funds from a non-Air District source(s) that will pay for any project-related costs in excess of an award.
- **Section 4.** AC Transit will comply with the program policies and guidelines including the requirement to operate and maintain the projects' equipment throughout the project term.
- **Section 5.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by four affirmative votes of the Board of Directors.
