**A RESOLUTION HONORING LINDA NEMEROFF ON THE OCCASION OF
HER RETIREMENT FOR 20 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE AS
BOARD ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER/DISTRICT SECRETARY OF AC TRANSIT**

WHEREAS, Linda Nemeroff was appointed by the AC Transit Board of Directors on November 16, 2006 to serve as the Board Administrative Officer/District Secretary, having previously served as the District’s Assistant District Secretary from September 1, 2005, until her appointment; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, Linda Nemeroff became a Certified Municipal Clerk by the International Institute of Municipal Clerks, after completing an extensive education program, further demonstrating her commitment to her excellence and professional development; and

WHEREAS, Linda Nemeroff has expertly managed the operations and strategic functions of the District Secretary’s office, overseeing elections, Board onboarding, compliance, and public inquiries, and drawing upon her strong business acumen and extensive background in state and county government service to ensure the smooth and effective governance of AC Transit; and

WHEREAS, Linda Nemeroff played a pivotal role in promoting digital integration and modernizing her office through innovative, cost-effective systems and processes that enhanced efficiency and accessibility, and through her forward-thinking approach to technology strengthened governance, transparency, and accountability while fostering a digitally proficient Board equipped with timely information to support effective oversight, policy guidance, and informed decision-making; and

WHEREAS, Linda Nemeroff has served the District faithfully with integrity, professionalism and commitment, often going above and beyond her official duties and after years of distinguished service, now retires, leaving behind a legacy of achievement and a standard of excellence for others to follow.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District does resolve as follows:

Section 1.
