

Transportation Network Company (TNC) Tax – ILC Presentation


CITY OF BERKELEY PUBLIC WORKS *TRANSPORTATION*





- Approved by voters as part of Measure GG in the 2020 General Election
- Levies a \$.50 tax on private trips and a \$.25 tax on pooled trips
- Estimated to generate approximately \$900,000 annually for general municipal services in Berkeley until January 1, 2041
- In 2023, City Council determined the TNC Tax shall be allocated as follows: ½ to traffic calming projects; and ½ to tier 1 bike/pedestrian/transit priority projects






Note: FY 25 is incomplete. FY 25 began July 1, 2024 and ends on June 30, 2025.

TNC Tax Expenditures

- ½ designated for bike/pedestrian/transit priority projects
- ½ designated for traffic calming projects





Fiscal Year 2024 Expenditures

- \$100,000 in short, medium, and long-term traffic calming measures in the vicinity of 2023 Halloween Derby St. hit-and-run incident
- 2. \$25,000 for five additional portable speed radar trailers bringing the City's total to seven for targeted traffic calming
- 3. \$325,000 to increase the citywide Traffic Calming Budget
- 4. \$450,000 to fund:
 - 1. Tier 1 protected bicycle lanes and crossings identified in the 2017 Bicycle Plan, including but not limited to quick-build projects;
 - Priority pedestrian street crossings identified in the 2020 pedestrian plan, including but not limited to quick-build projects; and
 - 3. Priority quick-build public transit projects under the Street Repair Program.
