

# Student Transit Pass Program

September 2024

#### Overview: STPP in HUSD

Purpose: Eligible middle and high school students in Alameda County can receive a Student Transit Pass. The pass includes <u>free and unlimited trips</u> on AC Transit, 50% off BART fares, and discounts on other transit systems in the Bay Area.

**Eligibility**: Students in grades 6 through 12 who are eligible for free or reduced-priced meals can apply for a Student Transit Pass. The pass remains valid until high school graduation as long as the student stays enrolled in a participating Alameda County school.



### Program Benefits

- Better school access
- Higher transit use
- Increased afterschool involvement
- Higher financial benefit
- Less frequent tardiness
- Positive perceptions of transit
