- The Form 990-N electronic-filing system moved from Urban Institute's website to IRS.gov in February 2016. All filers must register at IRS.gov prior to filing their next Form 990-N. This is a one-time registration; you won't be asked to register again when filing next year.
- Form 990-N must be completed and filed electronically. **There is no paper form.**
- Form 990-N filers may choose to file a complete Form 990 or Form 990-EZ instead.



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In projecting our budget, a few economic and administrative factors had to be taken into account. First, we had to consider as we stated earlier, the average Haitian makes 27 cents to a dollar per day, even though the Federal Government have established the minimum wage at \$5.11 per day. Our position is that this wage standard is not conducive to providing the level of education we aim to provide for our students. We have established the minimum wage for anyone working in our program in Haiti at \$3.25 per hour. We believe this will accomplish our vision in raising the community economically and it will also create the incentive for our staff to focus and dedicate themselves to the education of our children.



Second, to keep Those Angels, Inc. running, we need to have in place a team of individuals in the United States who will be responsible for the day to day administrative needs of the organization in the U.S and logistical support for the team in Haiti.

Third, this team will help coordinate shipping of needed supplies to our school and school bus program, also a cost of doing business reduction factor, they will be trusted with the task of conducting fundraising events, coordinating our grant writing efforts and lastly, making sure we are represented in the social media platforms among other things. Without this team supporting other teams in Haiti, Those Angels, Inc. vision will not be achieved. It is through our U.S team we will adhere the sustainability concerns of our programs. It is with this team we are going to raise and acquire the needed resources to sustain the projects in Haiti.

Our actual startup cost is \$930,989. However, due to the hard work of our volunteers, we have been able to acquire or raise a total of \$414,088 in in-kind donation leaving us with a discrepancy of \$516,089 which is fifty-five percent of the amount needed to start our programs.


Projected Five Year Budget: 2019-2024

For the next five years, a sum of \$3,017,428.49 will be required to provide education for approximately 1000 children and transportation for another 1500 children. In addition, these funds will support the economic needs of 15 families in Haiti and 4 families in the United States.

The budget is specifically written to be conservative as the organization is doing work as an international status. Therefore, we have to expect variances for unexpected expenses a normal organization would have to deal with, including administrative costs for fundraising and events, audits and the like. These variables also include security, unexpected economic instability and more. Included in this budget is an annual increase of 3% per year to make up for the equity of a growing healthy economy.

Additionally, the rise in the cost of doing business from FY 19/20 to 20/20 reflects the expected growth of the organization and the need for additional staff to care for the organization's needs. As stated during the FY 22/23, we will open our waiting list to welcome 25 more students, for this reason, we will need to hire another teacher to care for the educational needs of these students. The same is true for what is reflected in the FY 23/24, another 25 students will be admitted into our school achieving our goal of providing free education for 200 students.
