ALAMEDA-CONTRA COSTA TRANSIT DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO. 19-022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO TRANSFER OWNERSHIP OF THREE SURPLUS TRANSIT BUSES TO THOSE ANGELS, INC.

WHEREAS, the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District (AC Transit) is a special purpose district that provides bus service within its service area using buses of varying lengths obtained with local and/or federal funds; and

WHEREAS, AC Transit's service to its customers includes providing supplemental service to some of the school districts located within its service area; and

WHEREAS, after twelve to fifteen years of service to AC Transit's customers, transit buses are declared surplus and disposed of in accordance with Board Policy No. 461; and

WHEREAS, due to age and condition, surplus transit buses have nominal value to the District, usually averaging \$3,000 for over-the-road coaches at auctions; and

WHEREAS, AC Transit has been approached by the founder of *Those Angels, Inc.* a California non-profit corporation that has a school in Haiti for children in grades 1 through 6 and also provides school bus service to many children in Haiti due to a bus donation from Sacramento Unified School District. Because the corporation wishes to increase its school bus service, it is requesting the donation of three MCI coaches; and

WHEREAS, AC Transit has surplus MCI coaches which are available for donation;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District does resolve as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Contingent on the receipt of proof that the buses will be transported to Haiti and used for transporting school service, authorizes the General Manager to direct the transfer of ownership of up to three MCI coaches to *Those Angels, Inc.*

<u>Section 2.</u> The surplus buses are provided "AS IS", without any warranties or representations as to their condition. All costs, if any, associated with the transfer of title, transportation to the port of departure, shipping, export/import taxes/fees or any other costs associated with this donation shall not be borned by AC Transit, otherwise this resolution shall become null and void.

<u>Section 3.</u> In authorizing this resolution, the Board determines that the adoption of this resolution serves a public purpose because it is consistent with the provision of Board Policy No. 461; the surplus buses have nominal value to AC Transit; the buses will be used to enable students in a country with a high illiteracy rate to have the opportunity to receive an education; and that assisting in providing transportation to schools is consistent with the services provided by AC Transit in its own service area.

<u>Section 4.</u> This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption by four affirmative votes of the Board of Directors, subject to the provisions of Section 2.
