**BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:**

The Political Reform Act requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate Conflict-of-Interest Codes. Each year, officials and employees whose positions are designated in the District's Conflict-of-Interest Code must file an Annual Statement of Economic Interest with the District Secretary. The deadline to file, as established by the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC), was Wednesday, April 1, 2026.

The District Secretary's Office reports that all of 187 required annual filings were received before the filing deadline of April 1, 2026.
