#### Overview of Changes - Berkeley

- Lines 6, 51A, 51B, 72/72M unchanged in Berkeley.
- Lines 18 and 52 will run every 15 minutes, with Line 88 running every 20 minutes.
- New service to Elmwood and downtown Berkeley via Alcatraz and College on Line 29\*.
- Line 7 reduced to hourly and run via Adeline and Stanford to the Emeryville Public Market.
- Line 79 eliminated. North of University Ave, service provided by Line 27; service on Piedmont, Claremont, and College provided by Line 36 extension.
- Service reductions on Lines 65, 67, and 72R to bolster reliability elsewhere in the system.
