**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGET FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2021-22**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors adopted Resolution 21-035 on September 8, 2021, approving the FY 2021-22 Operating and Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has received and reviewed the General Manager's Recommended Mid-Year Budget Revisions for the FY 2021-22 General Fund Operating and Capital Budget; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District does resolve as follows:

Section 1. Amend the Fiscal Year 2021-22 General Fund Operating and Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 2021-22 Mid-Year Revisions as identified on the FY 2021-22 Mid-Year Budget Review Summary presented in Attachment 2 of Staff Report 21-042:

a.	Total Operating Revenues.	\$512.6M
b.	Total Operating Expenses.	\$512.6M
c.	Transfer to/(from) Unrestricted Net Assets.	\$0.0M
d.	District Funded Capital.	\$9.3M
e.	Transfers to/(from) General Fund	\$0.0M
f.	Total Capital Program Contribution.	\$9.3M

Section 2. Amend the Capital Budget as presented in Attachment 4 of Staff Report 21-140e.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by four affirmative votes of the Board of Directors.
