**Justification for Same Day Board Action:** The District has made an offer of employment to a candidate who has verbally accepted and requested relocation assistance. Since that request will be part of the negotiation process, it is requested the Board take same day action on this item.

## **Fiscal Impact:**

Approximately \$50,000

## **Background/Discussion:**

The current Director of Service Supervision will retire in the next month or two. The District began recruiting for a replacement and has made an offer that has been verbally accepted by the candidate. The candidate currently resides in Florida and a relocation package is being negotiated. The General Manager is requesting authorization to reimburse the candidate for the Director of Service Supervision for relocation expenses.

In Resolution 1180, the Board authorized the General Manager to exercise his discretion in reimbursing relocation expenses for contract employees. In addition, the District has previously reimbursed employees in management positions on a case-by-case basis, most recently for the Traffic Schedules Manager. The General Manager is requesting the authority to reimburse the candidate for relocation costs in an approximate amount of \$50,000 for expenses associated with the cost of moving personal possessions, vehicle(s), roundtrip airfare to facilitate location of permanent housing in the Bay Area, as well as potential temporary housing costs. Staff will ensure that the relocation costs are competitive.
