1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at approximately 9:00 a.m.

Moment of Silence

Public Comments

Three members of the public, Clarence Fischer, Adina Levin, and Aleta Dupree, provided public comment.

3. NEW DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Legislative Update (VERBAL)

Maria Henderson, External Affairs Representative for AC Transit, provided an update on state and federal legislation, focusing on the status of the regional transit funding measure (SB 63), and received feedback. Directors made comments related to Santa Clara County's participation being a risk to the measure's success and asked about the timing of efficiency measures and funding for college student passes and ferries.

Public Comment: Two members of the public, Adina Levin and Warren Cushman, provided comments on the legislative update.

B. Regional Mapping & Wayfinding Project Update

Jumana Nabti, Manager of Access Programs in the BART Customer Access and Accessibility Department, provided an update on the Regional Mapping and Wayfinding Project. Directors discussed the item, highlighting the importance of wayfinding for people with disabilities and the need for a clearly communicated rollout plan. Some Directors noted a preference for larger non-backlit signage over smaller backlit signs. A suggestion was made to include college and high school students in promotional outreach; Director Hernandez offered connections.

Public Comment: Three members of the public, Aleta Dupree, Clarence Fischer, and Warren Cushman, provided comments on the Regional Mapping and Wayfinding Update.

3. UPDATES ON PAST ITEMS

Robert del Rosario, Director of Service Development and Planning at AC Transit summarized updates on past items, including the AC Transit-BART Operator Restroom Agreement, Paratransit Update, and Service and Operations Updates. Directors discussed the item, with Director Ames expressing concerns about service frequencies to Cal State East Bay. Director Walsh requested AC Transit ridership updates be included in future service and operations reports.
