Public Participation and Public Comments

To make a live public comment, use the "raise your hand" feature in Zoom to indicate that you wish to speak on an item. You will be muted upon joining the meeting and unmuted by the meeting host when it is your turn to speak. The comment time is limited to 3 minutes per speaker.

Order of Agenda Items: The Board may discuss any item listed on this agenda and in any order.

Availability of Agenda Related Materials: Written agenda related materials for all open session regular meetings are available to the public 72 hours prior to the meeting or at the time the materials are distributed to a majority of the joint body. Written materials presented at a meeting by staff or a member of the joint body will be available to the public at that time, or after the meeting if supplied by an outside party.
