

## Transfer Provisions (local bus-local bus) Survey

Transfer provisions for single ride fare payment  
As of February, 2022

### Unlimited transfers within an amount of time

King County Metro (Seattle)	Within 2 hours
Metro (Minneapolis)	Within 2.5 hours
<b>Muni (San Francisco)</b>	<b>Within 2 hours</b>
RTD (Denver)	Within 3 hours (described as 3 Hour Cash Pass)
Trimet (Portland)	Within 2.5 hours
<b>VTA (Santa Clara)</b>	<b>Within 2 hours if paid on Clipper only</b>
WMATA (Washington)	Within 2 hours

### Unlimited one-way transfers (not for round trip)

LA Metro	Within 2 hours one way ( <i>previously had one ride and day passes</i> )
Metro (Houston)	Within 3 hours in one direction paid on Q Card, otherwise no transfers issued

### One free transfer

<b>County Connection</b>	<b>Within 2 hours if paid on Clipper only</b>
MBTA (Boston)	Within 2 hours (selected routes may become free fare)
Miami Dade Transit	Within 3 hours, one way (also has accumulator to day pass)
NYCT (New York)	No time period stated
<b>SamTrans</b>	<b>Within 2 hours if paid on Clipper/Mobile only</b>

### Two free transfers

CTA (Chicago)	Within 2 hours
<b>Marin Transit</b>	<b>Within 2 hours</b>

### Four free transfers in one direction

MARTA (Atlanta)	Within 3 hours, one way

### One free transfer, second transfer paid

SEPTA (Philadelphia)	Within 2 hours, second transfer \$1.00. (single ride fare \$2.50). ( <i>Was \$1 per transfer</i> )

### Transfer Charge

RT (Sacramento)	25 cents (base fare \$2.50)

### No transfers

<b>AC Transit</b>	<b>Day pass is 2.2 times base fare, Clipper discounted</b>
OCTA (Orange County)	Day pass paid on bus is 2.5 times base fare. Prepaid day pass (online or from retailers) is 2.25 times base fare.
MTS (San Diego)	Day pass is 2.4 times base fare
