Claudia Chief Financial Officer Allen presented information on the allocation methodology the Scott Nickerson, allocation of revenue, subsidies and expenses. an independent external auditor with Crow VV/C1 agreed-upon LLC, gave a review of Measure procedures applicable to the audit. the Director of Service Development **Planning** Robert del Rosario addressed how service and

service miles are determined and allocated in each of the two special districts.

Chair Abelson asked if there were reportable impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic for the committee's consideration. Chief Financial Officer Claudia Allen advised that the impact of the pandemic will show on the FY 2020-21 revenue and service report next year. She added that the District received CARES Act funds for the current fiscal year providing for a balanced budget and steady level of service.

General Manager Michael Hursh and staff briefly addressed questions from Committee members about revenue projections and service levels during the pandemic.
