

GMAC Voting Procedures

All actions taken by the Committee shall be by a motion passed by a majority of the voting members present at a meeting.

1. A main motion and a second to take any action is required.
The Chair shall repeat the motion upon request from a member of the Committee.
 - 1.A. A motion to amend the main motion may be made to add or strike words or phrases from the main motion. It takes precedence over a main motion and requires a second.
 - 1.B The motion to amend by substitution replaces the entire main motion and takes precedence and requires a second. If the substitute motion passes, no further action is required.
2. All votes shall be by roll call, except when the Committee is receiving information where no action is necessary.
Following a vote, the Chair shall announce whether the motion passed or failed and any dissenting votes or abstentions.
3. If leaving a meeting early, Committee members are requested to announce that they are leaving the meeting or inform the Chair who will make an announcement.
4. The minutes of the meeting shall accurately reflect the outcome of any vote taken during a meeting, including those members voting in the affirmative, those dissenting, and abstentions.
