## A RESOLUTION AMENDING BOARD POLICY 333 AND CHANGING ITS TITLE TO FARE POLICY GOALS AND METHODOLOGY

**WHEREAS**, The Board of Directors is authorized by Public Utilities Code section 25807 to establish reasonable rates and charges for the operation of the District; and

WHEREAS, Board Policy 333 (Fare Policy: Fares, Fare Structure, and fare Increases) was adopted on June 22, 2011; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2018, the Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 18-012 approving the Transbay Fare Schedule for FY 2020 – FY 2024; and

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2019, the Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 19-008 approving changes to the local fare structure and adopted the planned Local Fare Schedule for FY 2020 – FY 2024; and

**WHEREAS,** Board Policy 333 needs to be amended to reflect actions taken by the Board in determining fares and to conform the document's format with other District policies.

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Board of Directors of the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District does resolve as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Approves amendments to Board Policy 333, which include changing the name of the policy to "Fare Policy Goals and Methodology" as set forth in Exhibit A of this resolution.

<u>Section 2.</u> Board Policy 333, as set forth herein, shall become effective on July 1, 2019. Should any conflicts arise between this policy and Resolution Nos. 18-012 and/or 19-008 referenced above, the resolution(s) shall take precidence.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by four affirmative votes of the Board of Directors.
