Director Harper commented on the need to get Clipper cards in the hands of cash paying riders even if it is a special fare free Clipper card. He further believed that Transbay service should never be free.						
Director Shaw advised that she was more interested in offering a discounted fare rather than a free fare because of the issue of people riding the bus who aren't necessarily traveling to a destination.
