





Q7 Resuming pre-pandemic ride frequency (n = 672) [Q2 x Q7]









Top Routes - respondents rode 13 out of the top 20 highest passenger routes











Q13 Location (n = 1,280)









Q17 Age Group (% of Total)


Q22 English Fluency (if Q21 Yes)
