

AC Transit Service Changes
Effective Sunday, August 8, 2021

Highlights of changes:

- Bus lines and trips designed to serve schools resume for the fall.
- Connections are made to Alameda ferry terminals on Line 21 and the new Line 78 to Seaplane Lagoon.
- Transbay service increased or restored on 11 lines.

Service changes effective Sunday, August 8, 2021:

Line(s)	Description of Changes
21	On weekdays, selected morning and afternoon trips will serve the Harbor Bay Ferry Terminal. Other minor schedule changes.
33, 39, 51A, 97, 217	Trips that operate school days only resume for the fall. Other minor schedule changes on Line 95.
54	Two additional trips toward Merritt College, and four additional trips toward Fruitvale BART, are added on weekdays, to better serve students at Latitude High School.
76	Line 76 is extended north from Hilltop Mall to serve Richmond Parkway Transit Center.
78	New line travels from Fruitvale BART to the Seaplane Lagoon Ferry Terminal via Santa Clara Ave., Webster Street, and Ralph Appezato Memorial Parkway. Buses are timed to meet ferry departures in the morning and ferry arrivals in the evening.
95	Trips that operate school days only resume for the fall. Other minor schedule changes.
600–699	Lines that operate school days only resume for the fall. Lines 611, 621, 623, 624, 625, 631, 654, 657, 663, 667, 671, 675, 687, and 688, which were suspended during the pandemic, are wholly or partially restored. Most lines have revised schedules to accommodate changed bell times.
614	Line discontinued. Riders can take line 660 or 677.
639	Line discontinued. Riders can take Line 654 to areas along Redwood Road and 35th Avenue.
651	Line discontinued. Riders can take Line 51A.
668	Line discontinued. Riders can take Line 675.
679	Line discontinued. Riders can take Line 669.
E	Some service restored, with four trips to San Francisco in the mornings and five trips toward the East Bay in the evenings.
G	Some morning service is restored with four trips to San Francisco. One additional trip will operate to the East Bay in the evenings.

J	Three additional trips will operate toward San Francisco in the mornings, and one additional trip will operate to the East Bay in the evenings.
L	Two additional trips will operate toward the East Bay in the evenings.
LA	Two additional trips will operate toward the East Bay in the evenings.
NX	Three additional trips will operate toward the East Bay in the evenings. In the mornings, the first trip will operate earlier, leaving MacArthur Boulevard & 56th Avenue at 7:05 a.m.
NX3	Some service restored, with two trips to San Francisco in the mornings and six trips toward the East Bay in the evenings.
OX	Some service restored, with two trips to San Francisco in the mornings and four trips toward the East Bay in the evenings.
P	Some morning service is restored with five trips to San Francisco. Five additional trips will operate to the East Bay in the evenings.
V	Some morning service restored, with two trips to San Francisco in the mornings. Three additional trips will operate to the East Bay in the evenings.
W	Four additional trips will operate toward the East Bay in the evenings.
Other	Minor schedule changes are made on lines 12, 19, 20, 40, 54, 70, 72, 72M, 72R, 74, 86, 96, 200, 802, and NL.

“Minor schedule changes” are those that move the times of bus trips earlier or later by a few minutes.
