**Notes:** Steve Palmer of Van Scoyoc Associates presented information on infrastructure, proposed financing structures for new investment, federal legislative matters, the Surface Transportation Bill, earmark requests for AC Transit projects, and the FY 22 federal budget. Mr. Palmer also addressed questions from the Board with respect to cybersecurity funding for public agencies, security and non-police crime reduction measures, overlapping transportation funding bills, and funding for Green New Deal and other climate change proposals.

#### Public Comment:

**Katy Scott-Smith**, People's Transit Alliance of the East Bay Democratic Socialists of America (PTA-EBDSA), presented details about the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's distribution of the federal American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act funds. Scott-Smith asked that District staff be agile as it plans for the restoration of service and strategically utilize the ARP funding distribution for such services as hiring incentives and bonuses towards hiring operators.
