Consider authorizing lodging expenses for President Ortiz and Vice President Young to attend the Platinum Advisors 2021 Annual Client Retreat on October 19-20, 2021, in Sonoma, California.

#### STRATEGIC IMPORTANCE:

The Platinum Advisors 2021 Annual Client Retreat provides attendees the time to meet with agency representatives, government peers, and legislative and government professionals to discuss topics and emerging issues important to the District.

# **BUDGETARY/FISCAL IMPACT:**

Lodging expenses are estimated at \$1,000 for up to two nights.

# BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

Platinum Advisors has extended an invitation to President Ortiz and Vice President Young to attend their Annual Client Retreat in Sonoma, California on October 19-20, 2021. The retreat will provide panel discussions with top industry insiders, elected officials and Platinum's staff on the economic and political landscape in California.

Pursuant to Board Policy 155, no reimbursement is authorized for overnight accommodations in the counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, San Francisco, or San Mateo. However, Directors may receive reimbursement for overnight accommodations in the counties of Marin, Napa, Santa Clara, Solano and Sonoma, if prior Board approval is obtained.
