## **3.A.** AB 1234 Ethics Training.

Presenters: James C. Harrison & Omar El-Qoulag, Olson Remcho, LLP

James Harrison and Omar El-Qoulaq, Olson-Remcho, LLP, conducted the state mandated AB 1234 Ethics Training and covered the following topic areas:

- Personal financial gain by public servants;
- Laws relating to claiming perquisites of office;
- Government transparency laws; and
- Fair political practices laws.

Members of the Board of Directors and Board Officers completed 2 hours of training.
